
INTRODUCTION TO PROJECT MANAGEMENT

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Introduction to Project Management Workshop is designed to equip participants with the basic skills and knowledge necessary to start working in the area of Project Management. It is also recommended for those people wishing to undertake the Certificate IV in Project Management but who have limited project experience. Participants will develop a basic understanding of the key aspects of project management and will be able to apply a range of best practice tools and techniques. This will help to ensure the delivery of projects which meet scope, time, cost and quality constraints, whilst meeting or exceeding stakeholder requirements.

The skills, knowledge, tools and techniques gained will have application across a wide range of industry sectors and will be suitable for the management of small projects.

COURSE STRUCTURE & DURATION

This course is delivered as a 2 day Introduction to Project Management Workshop. The workshop will cover the following areas:

- Project Lifecycle Management
- Applying project scope, time and cost management techniques
- Identifying and managing project risks
- Identifying and satisfying stakeholder and quality requirements

COURSE COST & RESOURCES

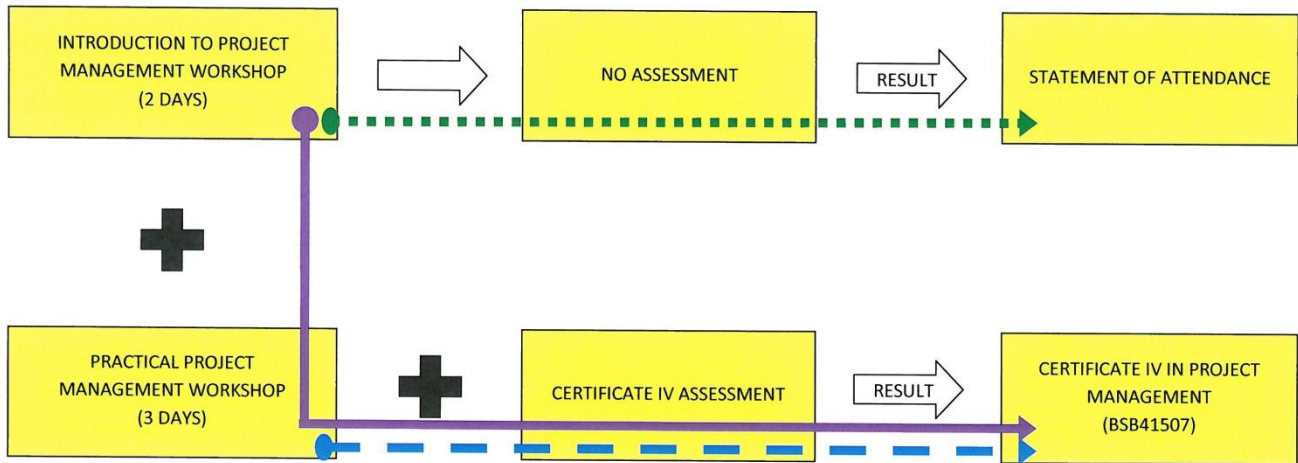
